GP AND SPECIALIST VISITS DURING PREGNANCY

- » Covered according to Scheme tariff for consultations with your GP and Gynaecologist, based on your plan and pregnancy trimester.
- » Ultra Affordable and Standard Options: your GP will refer you to a Gynaecologist for further tests and scans.
- » When submitting your referral, include your estimated due date to ensure timeous authorisation.



VITAMIN SUPPLEMENTS

- Prenatal vitamins (iron, calcium, and folic acid) are covered according to the approved formulary.
- » Benefits are pro-rated based on your pregnancy stage at registration.



VACCINATIONS

- The Scheme covers the inactivated Influenza (Flu) vaccine during pregnancy.
- These vaccines protect both mother and baby, providing passive immunity for the infant after birth.

Please Note: Antenatal classes and consultations with midwives are not covered under this Maternity Care Plan



ULTRASOUND SCANS

- » Ultra Affordable, Standard & Activator Options: Up to 2 scans per pregnancy.
- » Supreme & Extreme Options: Up to 3 scans per pregnancy



PATHOLOGY AND BLOOD TESTS

- » The Scheme covers a predetermined list of essential pregnancy tests (e.g., glucose and urine dipstick tests).
- Approved tests may vary depending on your Scheme plan and pregnancy trimester.





HOSPITAL BOOKING

Most hospitals require expectant mothers to **book their hospital bed in advance** — usually a few weeks before delivery. Please confirm your hospital booking **directly with your chosen facility and inform Umvuzo Health** once your booking is complete.

ELECTIVE CAESAREAN SECTION (C-SECTION)

An elective C-section must be medically indicated.

- » Covered from 39 weeks of pregnancy.
- » If done earlier, a doctor's motivation is required for approval.
- » Once authorised, the Scheme covers up to 4 days in a general maternity ward at 100% of the Scheme rate.
- » Exclusions: Private rooms and isolation without medical motivation.



PREMATURE BIRTH

If your baby is born **before 37 weeks**, cover applies according to Scheme rules and clinical guidelines.

- » Additional hospital days and NICU/High Care stays may be authorised if medically necessary and pre-approved.
- » Inform Umvuzo Health immediately of early delivery to avoid delays.



NORMAL OR VAGINAL DELIVERY

- » Covered up to **3 days** in a general maternity ward at 100% of the Scheme rate.
- » Pre-authorisation is required once your delivery plan is confirmed or when labour begins.
- » Exclusions: Private rooms or isolation (unless medically necessary).





NEWBORN REGISTRATION

- Register your newborn as a dependant within 30 days of birth to activate cover. Claims for your baby's care will only be paid once registration is complete.
- If registration is not done within 30 days, a threemonth waiting period applies before benefits can be accessed.
- How to register:
 - 1. Register your baby at the **Department of Home Affairs (DHA)**,
 - 2. Inform your **HR department** and contact Umvuzo Health on **0861 083 084**.
 - 3. Provide:
 - The main member's **ID copy**, and
 - The baby's DHA registration document.



SPECIALIST DOCTORS FOLLOW-UP VISITS

- Once your baby is registered within 30 days:
 Baby: A paediatrician consultation
 - Baby: A paediatrician consultation after birth, paid from specialist visits (pre-authorisation required) or Family Benefits, depending on your Option.
 - Mother: A gynaecologist consultation within 6 weeks after delivery, covered without pre-authorisation.



MATERNITY BAG

- » Every registered expectant mother will receive a Maternity Bag filled with essential items for you and your baby.
 - Issued from eight (8) months of pregnancy or later.
 - Delivery or collection arrangements will be communicated closer to the time.
 - Please keep your contact details updated to ensure smooth delivery.
- Our way of celebrating your journey and supporting you as you prepare to welcome your little one.

PLEASE BE READY TO SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION WHEN REQUESTING PRE-AUTHORISATION

To ensure there are no delays to your request, please ensure you have on hand the following:

- » Your membership number,
- » The referral letter from the doctor,
- » ICD 10 code (in other words the diagnosis code),
- » The name and practice number of your referring doctor,
- The name and practice number of the specialist to whom you are referred, and
- » Any other related documents as may be required.

Once your request has been processed and approved, you will then be sent your authorisation number on your mobile by SMS and email where applicable. Administrative and Client services are attended to during business hours from:
